# VEP Collaborates with California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation to Assist Veterans

On February 14, 2024, the County of Orange's Veterans Employment Program (VEP) collaborated with the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation's Division of Adult Parole Operations, Parole and Community Team (PACT) meeting and provided a brief overview of VEP services to over 50 recently released parolees. Veterans among the attendees received personalized support and were connected to the Orange County Veterans Service Office (VSO) for additional benefits assistance, alongside VEP services.

#### VA Expands Healthcare Benefits for Veterans with Cancer

On March 8, 2024, the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) announced new steps to increase life-saving screenings and access to benefits for Veterans with cancer. Key takeaways include:

- 1. Urethral Cancer Presumption: Within 90 days, urethral cancers will be presumptively linked to service for eligible Gulf War and post-9/11 Veterans.
- 2. Urinary Bladder and Ureteral Cancers Evaluation: VA will assess if these cancers are linked to toxic exposures for Gulf War and post-9/11 Veterans, potentially adding them to presumptive conditions.
- 3. Expanded Screening: By year-end, VA aims to offer genetic testing to all eligible Veterans, expand lung cancer screening, and provide over 1 million Veterans with convenient colorectal cancer screening.
- 4. Enhanced Smoking Cessation Support: VA continues to boost smoking cessation services, adding more sites to the Quit VET eReferral program and including cessation services in lung cancer screening programs.

## DID YOU KNOW?

The VSO has Veterans Claims Representatives who are VA-accredited. Veterans and their beneficiaries should beware of unaccredited individuals offering to help with benefits claims. These individuals are not allowed to do the following by law:

- · Consult or give advice to Veterans about their VA claims.
- · Collect evidence for a claim.
- · Prepare and file initial or supplemental claims.
- Submit requests for higher level review.
- Submit an appeal to the Board of Veterans' Appeals.

For free benefits claims counseling, schedule an appointment at veterans.ocgov.com or walk into the VSO office at 1300 South Grand Avenue, Building B, Santa Ana, CA 92705. Operation hours are Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Tuesday from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.
