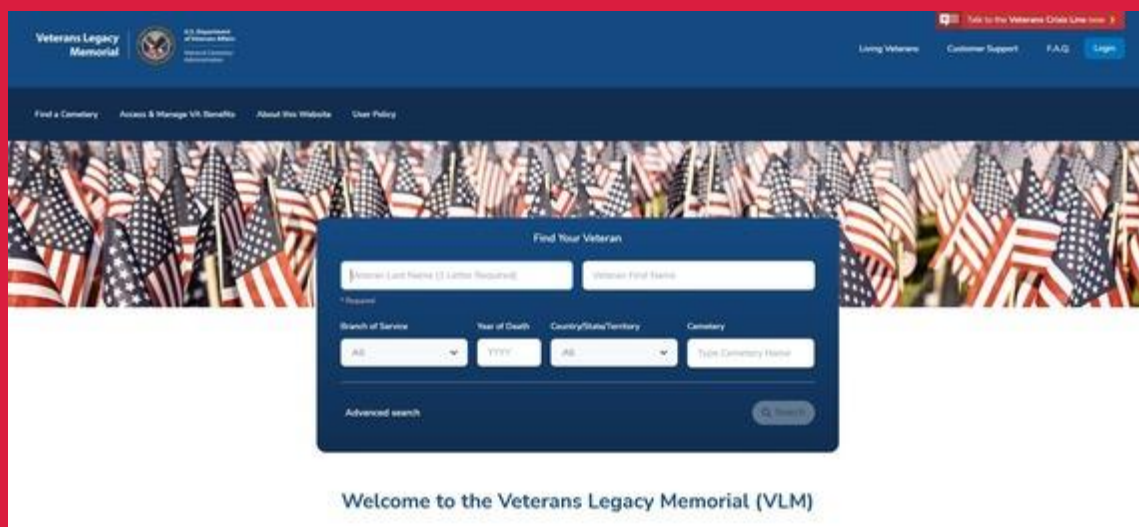

VA Broadens Online Memorials for Veterans Buried Overseas

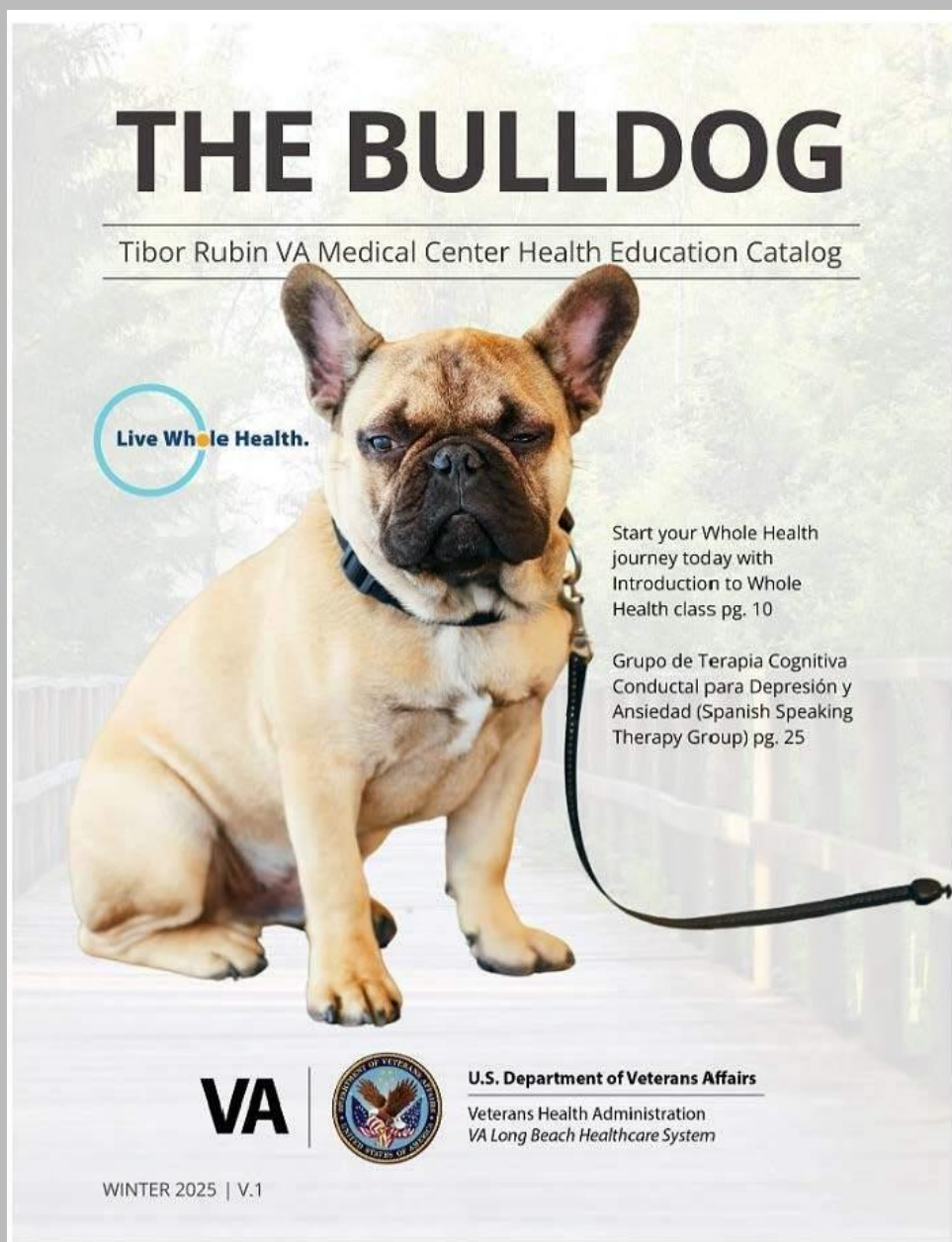
The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) has expanded its *Veterans Legacy Memorial* (VLM) website to include 210,000 additional pages honoring Veterans interred in overseas cemeteries and memorials managed by the American Battle

Monuments Commission (ABMC). This partnership between the VA's National Cemetery Administration and the ABMC brings the total number of VLM memorial pages to over 10 million, making it the largest online memorial in the U.S. dedicated to Veterans and Service Members.

VLM allows families and loved ones to honor Veterans by sharing tributes, photos, biographies, and other documents. Living Veterans who are approved for pre-need burial in a VA national cemetery can also share their stories through the "Your Life, Your Story" feature.
