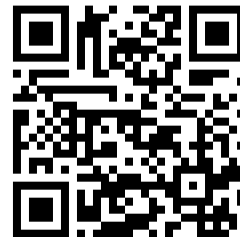

## OUR MISSION

The Orange County Veterans Service Office (VSO) actively pursues the rights of veterans of the United States Armed Forces, and their dependents and survivors to receive U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) benefits. The VSO works collaboratively with the VA, with nationally chartered veteran's organizations, and others, to assure that veterans, their dependents and/or survivors receive the entitlements the veterans earned while serving in this Country's military services.



## OUR HISTORY

The County of Orange established the veteran's service program in 1929. On August 17, 1945, it was established as an independent program as the Orange County Veterans Service Office.

## HOW DO I BEGIN?

1. Walk into the VSO office or book an appointment.
2. Prepare your documents for day of appointment:
  - Military separation documents:
    - Marriage/divorce decrees.
    - Medical records (if applicable).
    - Social Security Numbers (veteran and dependents).
3. If you are a walk-in without an appointment and:
  - Previously filed a claim with DVA, please bring a copy of the decision letter (if available).
  - Seeking to apply for benefits for the first time, you may be asked to provide additional documentation.

## WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

1. A Veterans Claims Representative will conduct an interview during your appointment to assess your eligibility for benefits with the VA, initiate a claim, submit our documents, and answer questions relative to benefits.
2. Once you receive a decision letter on your claim, a claims representative can help explain the results of the VA decision.
